#### THE FINE PRINT (LITERALLY)

Providing the information requested on this form confirms that you've read the fine print below, and that you understand and agree with how we do things. Take a moment to read them, complete this form, then bring it by the front table. If you're confident in your math, feel free to mail it in with a check. Otherwise, just stop by, and we'll finish up in person.

EARLY REGISTRATION Existing students may carry their current lesson time into the new year by registering before the final day of the current school year. After that date, the schedule is purged, and we begin fulfilling early registration requests for the new school year. The earlier you register, the more likely you will get the class and lesson times you prefer.

NO "HIDDEN"

As parents, we've always been frustrated by the hidden fees that are common with extracurricular activities so... we're committed to never charging them. Our tuition is all-inclusive, with a single, annual registration fee of \$75. There are no recital fees, no costume fees, and no testing fees, ever, You'll have to purchase tickets to see our shows, but that's it. Occurse, you'll have to bring the customary clothing, instruments, and books necessary to practice your art, but we won't surprise you with any hidden costs once we've signed you up. What you see on the tuition chart is what you pay. Period.

LATE FEES

We work hard to keep our tuition affordable, and offer a variety of tuition options that provide payment flexibility. Any payments that are more than 30 days past due will be assessed a 10% late fee, which will be compounded each additional month that the invoice remains unpaid. In order for us to do what we do, we need you to pay your tuition on time. It's that simple.

MAKE-UP LESSONS Part of what makes the Arts Center work well for our teachers is that they get paid for every lesson that is on the schedule for that week, even if the student doesn't show up. Because of this, instructors aren't paid for make up lessons (since they've already been paid). Of course, we understand that absences do happen, and we will allow one make up lesson each school year. If an instructor misses, or we are forced to close due to weather, we will schedule a make up lesson as soon as possible, or offer a credit for the missed week. Make-ups (for group classes) may be scheduled, as availability permits, in another class that is both age and level appropriate.

DISCIPLINE & EXPULSION POLICY Trinity Arts Center manages disciplinary issues according to a "three strikes" policy designed to: <a href="communicate">communicate</a> clearly and quickly to all of the parties involved; ensure the safety of our students and faculty, and <a href="preserve">preserve</a> a <a href="positive</a> and healthy environment for our students and teachers. The first occurrence of any behavioral problems will result in a conversation with the parents. After a second occurrence, the student will be expelled from class for two weeks. A third occurrence will result in immediate expulsion from class for the year. Trinity Arts Center reserves the right to immediately expel any student, parent, or patron who, in our estimation, represents a threat to the safety of our students or instructors.

LIABILITY RELEASE Some activities at the Arts Center include the risk of physical injury. By participating in the classes, lessons, or programs at Trinity Arts Center, you assume that risk and agree that <u>Trinity Arts Center</u>, our instructors, and our agents aren't <u>liable for injuries</u> sustained, or loss of personal property, during attendance at the center or its functions.

MEDICAL PERMISSION In the case of injury, we'll always try to contact you first. If we can't reach you, we'll do everything we can to take care of your kids like they are our own. In your absence, we'll get them to a doctor who can make any necessary medical decisions.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Sometimes, we use photos of our students and their families on our web site or on other materials that help illustrate and promote what we do at Trinity Arts Center. Pictures will never be sold, licensed, or used in any other

manner without express written consent from you.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE <u>Trinity Arts Center gives away approximately 10% of our annual revenue in the form of scholarships</u> to students whose families need help covering the cost of tuition. Generally speaking, those scholarships can cover up to 50% of the applicable tuition for families demonstrating need and a unique level of talent and dedication. Scholarships are not offered for private lessons.

CANCELLATION &

Students may withdraw from class at any time. However, <u>tuition is always</u>, <u>calculated through the end of the quarter</u> in which lessons or classes are cancelled. In addition, <u>credits or refunds will not be provided until the front desk (not the instructor) has been notified</u>. As I mentioned earlier, the teachers continue to be paid if the lesson is on our schedule. It's important that you let us know if you're not oping to attend.

INCLEMENT WEATHER We do not follow the cancellation schedule of any school system. It is extremely rare for our classes to be cancelled due to inclement weather (snow is usually cleared by the time we start classes). In the case of a cancellation, we'll send an e-mail, update our answering machine, and post a notice on the home page of our web site at trinityartscenter.com by noon of the day in question. Cancellations will be subject to our refund policy (above).

GOD IS GOOD. THE BIBLE IS TRUE. JESUS SAVES. Trinity Arts Center is a Christian organization. Our teachers profess Jesus as Lord and adhere to the Bible as the inerrant and only Word of God.
